Economic Zones Struggle to Woo Foreign Investors

Investment scenario at the state sponsored Economic Zones

- No of public economic zones: 5
- ☐ Total proposed investment: **USD 22.17 billion**

78% Cropland in BD Lacks Essential Organic Matters

- ☐ Nearly **78**% of the total arable land suffers a shortage of necessary organic matters
- A 2.8 times higher production since the 1980s, a vast rise in grain, potato, vegetable and other crop production, also took its heavy toll as soil lacks a shortage of seven key nutrients ⁴





VENTURE CAPITAL

HypeScout Raises USD 280,000 Pre-seed Funding

- The round was led by **Anchorless Bangladesh**, a New York based early-stage venture capital firm
- hypescout HypeScout, founded in 2021
 - ☐ The platform creates opportunities for these micro influencers to monetize their follower base by giving them exposure to brands 5

SWAP Raises BDT 5 Crore



- **SWAP**, the local re-commerce platform, has raised funding **BDT 5 crores** in Pre-Series A round from Startup Bangladesh
- SWAP has generated more than **BDT 443 crore** in GMV since their launch in **2020** ⁶

Startup Bangladesh Invests in Bimafy

- ☐ A agreement was signed between the organisations for investing **BDT 1 crore**
- Bimafy, which enables customers to avail of insurance services through an online platform 7

Gachihata Aqua's Output Tumbles for Working Capital Shortfall

☐ Gachihata Aquaculture Farms Ltd – an agro-based firm delisted from the stock exchanges – is not able to run business in full swing owing to a working capital shortage

- ☐ The Bangladesh Bank has raised the lending rate cap on consumer loans to 12%
- ☐ Double digit interest can be charged on personal and car loans only
- ☐ The new interest rate cap will be applicable only to fresh loans 11

ICB Could Lose BDT 438 Crore for Unusual Investment Decisions

- ➤ Incurred losses of **BDT 174 crore** for purchasing share of Padma Bank at premium prices
- ➤ Made non-profitable investment of **BDT 154 crore** 12
- ☐ ICB's net profit after tax BDT 144.58 crore
- ☐ Total asset BDT 19000 crore
- ☐ Investment made by ICB BDT 2499 crore

ACI Incurred Losses



- ACI Limited, incurred losses of BDT 18.59 crore in the Q1 due to higher interest costs and depreciation of the local currency against the dollar
- ☐ The company's profits for FY2022-23 were down 25% compared to BDT 24.82 crore during the same period a year earlier ¹³

Walton Makes Bangladesh's Maiden Electric Bike



- **Walton**, received approval from the Bangladesh Road Transport Authority (BRTA)
- Annual manufacturing capacity of 2.5 lakh units
- ☐ Global electric bike market generated USD 45.75 billion 14
